

LOCATION and TRAVEL

BY ROAD Exit M42 at J4 for A34 Birmingham. At 4th roundabout turn right onto Cranmore Boulevard and right at 2nd mini roundabout onto Highlands Road, then first left onto Cranmore Avenue. Sat. Nav. postcode B90 4LF.

PARKING The main car park is in front of the building with overflow car parks and further unrestricted roadside parking in surrounding non residential area.

BY RAIL Both Solihull Station (Chiltern Railways) and Shirley (London Midland) are 2 Miles from Cranmore Park. Birmingham International is 8 miles.
