IOLI and the Beehive Lacers Guild would like to invite you to join us for the 60th Annual IOLI Convention in Salt Lake City, Utah. The theme is *The Great Salt Lake*. Salt Lake City is Utah's capital and the gateway to the state's renowned ski resorts, scenic national parks and recreational areas. The Historic Mormon Temple Square is a popular attraction. Come and experience outstanding classes, a beautiful lace display and wonderful vendors. Visit area highlights and meet other lace makers during an exciting week full of lace events. The Beehive Lacers website can be accessed via the IOLI website at internationaloldlacers.org, convention tab.

This year's convention will be held at the Sheraton Salt Lake City Hotel, 150 West 500 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84101 (Sheraton.com). The hotel is located in the downtown area of the city within walking distance of restaurants and close to shopping. Hotel amenities include several restaurants, communal lounge with computer services, free Wi-Fi in the hotel lobby, high speed internet in the rooms (\$9.95 per day charge), and a pool and fitness center. Refrigerators are available upon request. For those who wish to drive, there is free parking. Room rates, exclusive of taxes, are: \$139 single, \$139 double, \$149 triple, \$159 quadruple and \$199 suites. **Reservations must be made with the hotel by July 15, 2013 to guarantee these rates.** Check-in time is 3:00 PM and check-out is 12:00 PM. **To request room reservations, call the hotel's toll free number 1-888-627-8152. The reservation code is IOLI13.**

Airport: The Salt Lake City International Airport is located five miles northwest of downtown Salt Lake City. Complimentary shuttle service to and from the airport is available. Upon your arrival in Salt Lake City, contact the hotel at 1-801-401-2000. The shuttle operates from 5:00 AM to midnight. Taxis are available from the airport (\$20) and train station (\$10). In addition, the hotel provides limited free shuttle service in the area surrounding the hotel. Parking onsite is complimentary for hotel guests. Both self-park and valet parking is available. Rental car services are available through the hotel.

Registration: February 1, 2013 will be the official opening day for registration. However, forms may be mailed in anytime. Any forms received before February 1, 2013 will be considered as received on that day for the purpose of assigning classes. The registration fee of \$190 includes the opening dinner on Sunday evening, convention luncheon on Tuesday, banquet on Friday evening, convention bag, name tag and convention pin. Class fees are \$450/30 hr class, \$360/24 hr class, \$180/12 hr class, \$90/6 hr class and \$45/3 hr class. A check or money order in US funds to cover registration, classes, optional tours, and guest tickets must accompany your registration form. Fees for registration and classes cancelled prior to May 15, 2013 will be refunded with the exception of \$50. After May 15, no refunds will be made, but you may find a substitute to attend the convention and your chosen classes in your place. Any registrations received after July 1, 2013 will be considered depending on availability of openings in classes. All lace enthusiasts are welcome to attend; however, current IOLI members will be given preference in class choice.

Box lunches: For your convenience, the hotel is offering a box lunch for Monday (\$25) and Thursday (\$25) to coincide with the Arachne and OIDFA meeting lunches. This is optional for all convention attendees (sign up for either the Arachne and OIDFA or the optional box lunch, not both). If you don't attend the Arachne or OIDFA lunch, you may take your lunch to the outdoor central gardens, lobby areas or wherever you choose. Sign up on the registration form.

Arachne lunch: Arachne is an online discussion about lace and lace making, especially bobbin and needle laces. The Monday lunch from 11:45-1:15 PM is an opportunity for members of that discussion group to meet face-to-face. A box lunch (\$25) is offered on your registration form.

OIDFA Meeting: Everyone is invited to the Thursday lunch from 11:45-1:15 PM. It is an opportunity for OIDFA members to become acquainted and for non-members to learn about and possibly join OIDFA, The International Bobbin and Needle Lace Organization. Registration in advance is requested and the box lunch is \$25.

Display Room: In addition to the regular display, there will be special categories for young lacers up to 10 years old and for those from 11 to 16 years old. There will be a popular vote and ribbons for each group. The Utah Embroidery Guild will display some of their work. Please let the display room chairperson know by June 30, 2013 if you are intending to display so that she will have time to do the exhibit placards for your lace. Tours: Wednesday, August 7, 2013. Check the Beehive Lacers website for additional information.

Tour 1: Quilt Show and Olympic Park Tour, 9:00-4:00 (\$60). Travel south of Salt Lake to Springville to see the 40th annual Utah Quilt Show, then northeast to Park City to the Alf Engen Ski Museum and Winter Olympic Park. Enjoy lunch (included in tour price) poolside, while watching athletes train for winter sports, and then visit the sites of the 2002 Olympic Winter Games.

Tour 2: Utah Opera, Cathedral of the Madelaine, Pioneer History Museum Tour, 9:30-2:30 (\$45). Guided tour of the Utah Opera Company production studio featuring a tour of the costumes, visit The Cathedral of The Madeleine, (a Roman Catholic church in Salt Lake City), meet with the other tours for a Victorian luncheon at the Lion House (12:00-1:00), home of Brigham Young, followed by a visit to the Daughters of the Utah Pioneers Museum with a tour of the pioneer era lace. (Lunch included in tour price.)

Tour 3: Temple Square and Vicinity Tour, 9:00-1:00 or 12:00-4:00 (\$35). Join us for a guided tour of Temple Square including tours of the North and South Visitors Centers, Tabernacle, Assembly Hall, Church History Museum, Family History Library and Conference Center. Morning tour ends and afternoon tour begins with a Victorian luncheon at the home of Brigham Young, the Lion House. (Lunch included in tour price.)

Other Offerings:

August 8 – Thursday evening (\$5 transportation ticket). The Mormon Tabernacle Choir rehearses each Thursday night at the Tabernacle from 8:00-9:30 (you may come and go, no need to stay the entire time). The rehearsal is free of charge. A bus has been reserved that will begin shuttling to and from downtown Salt Lake City (Temple Square) and the hotel at 6:00 pm. The last shuttle return to the Sheraton Hotel is 9:50 PM. Come downtown for dinner, shopping at the new City Creek Center, attend the choir rehearsal, and enjoy an evening on the town.

August 6 – Tuesday, Mountain Man Adventure Husband's Tour, 9:00-4:00 (\$50). Guided mountain hike (walking trails, low impact) Dutch Oven lunch, and mountain man demonstrations.

Large bag for pillows: The Beehive Lacers group is offering attendees a special bag large enough for a pillow. It measures 30" x 26" with an inside pocket, handles long enough to carry on your shoulder and a zipper closure at the top. It can be ordered on the registration form. Disposable pillow: Don't have room in your luggage for a second pillow? The Beehive Lacers group will have disposable pillows made from builders foam available for your use for \$5 each. Bring a cover cloth or fabric to cover the foam.

TV table rental: For \$5.00 the local group will rent a TV tray for you to use as a pillow stand or as an extra table while at convention. No need to stack chairs for the right height for your lace pillow during class or to find a table for homework.
