Lace in Bloom Contest:

Rules and information:

- 1) Original design or published FLOWER pattern.
- 2) One entry per person.
- 3) No larger than 12" x 12" x 12" in any direction including mounting (that you supply), must be free standing, i. e., if a wall hanging- supply an easel for display.
- 4) Any lace technique or combination thereof: can be a single flower or grouping.
- 5) Can be brought the morning of Lace Day or the night before.
- 6) Open to all Lacemakers.
- 7) Voting will be by cash amount in the container for that entry.
i.e. \$1.00 = 100 votes
- 8) Must be pre-registered. (See below.)

Contest Prizes:

1st Place: the highest amount will win all cash in that container

2nd Place: half of the cash in that container

3rd Place: one-third of the cash in that container

Registration:

Must be pre-registered by snail/email with the following information by Monday, April 8: Name, Email, Phone, Technique(s), Pattern source or original design, and Name of piece
