Scheduled times are 10:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

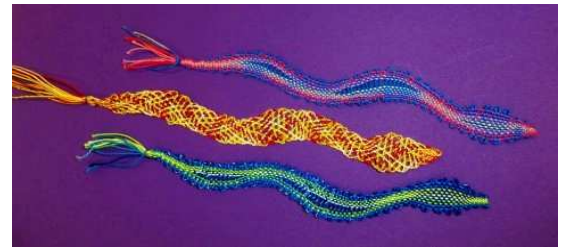

Colored pencils - green, red, purple, yellow.

Cover cloths, pins, scissors, etc. (It will be helpful if you know how to plait with 8 bobbins) .
