

April Showers Bring May Flowers

An introduction to Needle Lace taught by Katrina Middleton

In this two-day class, suitable for beginners or intermediate students, we'll cover the five basic steps of needle lace, including how to prepare the pattern and couch the design outline. We'll make a three-dimensional Spring Flower using the most popular needle lace filling stitches and learn two different edgings.

Skill level: beginner to intermediate, some experience with a needle and thread such as simple embroidery is helpful.

There will be a \$10 kit fee (payable to the instructor) to cover written instructions and supplies provided by the teacher. Students supply basic sewing tools, and 3 balls of tatting cotton. Detailed supply list will be provided upon sign up.
