- 1. Beginning Tatting: Armistice Turtora. Supply List: Tatting Shuttle, scissors and size 10 or 20 tatting thread.
- 2. Advanced Tatting: Mary Kay Totty. Dangle Ring Earrings with Beads (adapted from a bracelet pattern by Maria Papia) <u>Prerequisite: Basic Shuttle Tatting skills including rings, chains, lock joins. Class is limited to 8 students.</u>
 - Supply list: Students bring: two shuttles, scissors and students can provide their own supplies as listed below or a Kit is available from the Instructor for \$5 in a variety of color options. Kits include ear wires, size 20 thread, seed beads, two larger beads or charms, and beading needle.
